Privacy Policy

1. We respect your privacy

- 1.1. Monica Clare Recruitment Pty Ltd respects your right to privacy and is committed to safeguarding the privacy of our customers and website visitors. - 1.2. "Personal information" is information we hold which is identifiable as being about you.

2. Collection of personal information

- 5.4. Information that we collect may from time to time be stored, processed in, or transferred between parties located in countries outside of Australia. These may include but are not limited to Australia. If there is a change of control in our business or a sale or transfer of business assets, we reserve the right to transfer to the extent permissible at law our user databases, together with any personal information and non-personal information contained in those databases. This information may be disclosed to a potential purchaser under an agreement to maintain confidentiality.
